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Road Covering Materials.

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a) Principal Materials.

*Natural Materials.*

STONES :

*Primary* :— (granite, syenite, diorite, porphyry, trachyte, basalts, etc.)

*Secondary* :— (sandstones, greywacke, limestones, etc.), in the forms either of

*Pavement or of Metal.*

WOOD.

*Artificial Materials.*

STONES (clinkers, vulcanole, basaltoid, etc.)

ASPHALT.

b) Subsidiary Materials.

Cement, sand and tar.

c) **Dust-Binding Media.**

*Salts soluble in water* (chloride of calcium, chloride of magnesium, aconia, etc.)

*Oils soluble in water* (westrumite, expressole, duralite, etc.).
